Our History

The Horsham Museum Society founded the museum in 1893. Originating in the Unitarian Church on Worthing Road, the Society has continued to guide and support the museum ever since, becoming the charity Friends of Horsham Museum & Art Gallery in 2010.

The Museum Society was initially responsible for the running of the museum but handed this over to Horsham District Council in 1966. The Museum Society/ Friends have continued to seek ways of supporting the museum, from holding talks, establishing a garden and purchasing objects to conserving those within the collection.

Over the years the Society, and now the Friends, have raised substantial funds for the museum to develop its collections. We have supported the museum in establishing the Watercolour Collection and provided finance for the enhancement of Post Medieval exhibits.
